



The Old Fullerians' Association (OFA)

(Founded 1894)

The OFA is the alumni organisation for Watford Boys Grammar School and all former pupils are eligible to join at any time.

Whilst the Association is run independently by a General Committee - made up of volunteers (who themselves are all former pupils) - it works very closely with the School to ensure it maintains its principles. In accordance with the OFA constitution, these remain "to provide opportunities for former pupils of the School to keep in contact and to further the interests of the School by giving it every assistance".

This is achieved by organising a wide and varied calendar of events held throughout the year including sporting (cricket, football, golf, rugby), business (lunch and dinner clubs) and social occasions (quiz evenings, river cruises) with the Annual Dinner (held in the iconic School Hall each January) being the OFA's flagship event.

The OFA offers many opportunities for its members to give back to this great School such as Careers mentoring, Dragons' Den, Members' Business Club and financial donations (these, despite our very modest current annual subscription, have totalled some £44,000 in recent years).

The OFA's annual subscription, payable on the 1st April by standing order, is £15 currently. As we strive to continue to improve our services this will now increase to £25. (Whilst only becoming effective from the 1st April 2023 for current Members – naturally, the OFA would be delighted if they feel able to increase their standing order in the meantime!).
